

Rule 20 (Opening paragraph only)	20. In order to provide opportunities for effective representation of – and participation by – members, area structures shall be established – as set out in Schedule 1 – within each of the Union's sectors, as defined in Rule 21. These area structures will generally be defined on a geographical basis. However, where practicable, area structures may also be defined on the basis of grade or role where there are sufficient numbers of members to justify the creation of such structures. Proposals for the composition of each area shall be developed and reviewed, as necessary, by the Sector Committee for final decision by the General Council.	20. - * One of the six shall be employed in Great Britain.
- ** Bank of Ireland Group Greater Dublin comprises all workplaces in Dublin City and County together with workplaces in Bray, Celbridge, Dunboyne, Dunshaughlin, Greystones, Leixlip and Maynooth.
- [†] At least four of these shall be employed in the retail operations and at least four shall be employed in departments in the Bank of Ireland Greater Dublin area.
- ‡ Danske Bank's Belfast and District comprises all workplaces in the City of Belfast together with workplaces in Ballyclare, Ballynahinch (including Saintfield), Bangor, Comber, Downpatrick, Hillsborough, Larne, Lisburn, Newtownabbey (including Mallusk) and Newtownards.
- *** Ulster Bank Limited Belfast and District comprises all workplaces in the City of Belfast together with workplaces in Glengormley, Mallusk, Monkstown, Newtownards and Newtownbreda.

NEW RULE

- Secretary (ex officio).
- 1.5 The positions of Honorary Secretary and Honorary Finance Officer are included within the total number of General Council members for the sector in which they are elected.
- 1.6 The formula set out in 1.2 above applies to the numbers of members in each of the five sectors shown in 1.1; it does not apply to any individual employments that may be a sub-part of any one of those sectors.

2. Allocation of Elected Representatives into Constituencies

- 2.1 The numbers of elected representatives in each Sector will be allocated into constituencies within the Sectors.
- 2.2 These constituencies will be used for the purpose of member representation, and the nomination and election of elected representatives.
- 2.3 The process of allocation will take place as soon as possible following the determination of numbers of elected representatives per section 1 of this schedule.
- 2.4 Each Sector Officer, in consultation with their Sector Committee, shall produce a proposal for how the elected representatives in their sector are to be allocated within constituencies for the forthcoming electoral term. This proposal shall be made to the Governance and Ethics Committee on a date agreed by the General Council in advance of the Triennial Delegates Conference
- 2.5 If any Sector(s) do not bring forward a proposal within the required timeline, the General Council will determine the allocation of the elected representatives into constituencies, having regard for the criteria in section 3 of this Schedule.
- 2.6 The proposals from each Sector should also have regard for the criteria set out in section 3 of this schedule and should include a brief rationale for how the final allocation has been determined.
- 2.7 The Governance and Ethics Committee will have oversight of this process on behalf of the General Council. It will receive and review proposals and will make observations and recommendations to the General Council as appropriate. It will also provide input and support and will consult with Sector Officers.
- 2.8 To allow for nominations and elections to take place in a timely manner, proposals will require approval by General Council in sufficient time to allow the elections take place.

		2.9 General Council will be responsible to ensure that the allocation process proposed in each sector has had regard for the criteria in section 3 of this schedule.
		 Criteria for allocation of Elected Representatives into Constituencies The allocation of elected representatives into constituencies will have regard for the following criteria: Location and distribution of members; Structure of Bank or Sector; Consistency and transparency; Best interests of members.
